Summary Statement

KrisEnergy has a formal responsibility for the health, safety and welfare of staff and the impact of KrisEnergy activities on the health and safety of others.

To fulfil our responsibilities we need to ensure that:

- Hazards and risks are understood, assessed and controlled
- Staff are provided with the information, instruction, training and supervision to ensure they can undertake tasks safely
- Compliance with legal requirements is achieved, with a view to safety management and performance
- Staff are competent in their understanding of health and safety matters and accept and comply with their safety responsibilities
- Adequate measures are in place to prevent work injury and occupational ill health to all staff and people working on behalf of the company
- There are systematic procedures operating for monitoring and review of safety performance and the implementation of corrective action as required.
- Adequate resources are provided to meet safety objectives.
- Leadership commitment to communicating, achieving and promoting health and safety objectives and culture is evident.
- KrisEnergy will review its Health and Safety policy on a yearly basis or earlier if circumstances warrant, to ensure its continuing relevance to the structure and needs of the organisation.
