



KrisEnergy announces change to Board of Directors

Singapore, 30 May 2019 – KrisEnergy Ltd. (“KrisEnergy” or the “Company”, and together with its subsidiaries, the “Group”), an independent upstream oil and gas company, announces that Non-executive Independent Director Mr Keith Pringle has submitted his resignation from the Board of Directors with immediate effect.

Mr Pringle, who has served on KrisEnergy’s Board as a director or an advisor since 2009, also retires as a member of the Audit & Risk Management Committee and the Remuneration Committee. The Company remains in compliance with the required minimum of three members of the Audit & Risk Management Committee taking into account this cessation.
